

MINUTES

SPECIAL CALL COUNCIL MEETING

5-29-12

The Westmoreland City Council held a special call meeting on Tuesday, May 29, 2012 in the Community Meeting Room located at 5300 Austin Peay Hwy. The purpose of the meeting was:

1. Water meter for Troutt property located at 1646 Pleasant Grove Rd.
2. Resolution #511 – Water line extension for Old Hwy 52 to Macon Co. Line.
3. Second reading on Ordinance #516 – Regulation of the sale of beer.

Mayor Carter called meeting to order at 7 PM.

Devotion given by David Harrison. Pledge to flag was given.

Roll call: Mayor Carter – present

Councilmembers – Cline-present, Freeman-present, Harrison-present, Reeves-present, Smalling-present.

Motion by Larry Reeves second Dawn Freeman to waive the water tap and meter fee at 1646 Pleasant Grove Rd. because of property owner granting easement over the property for the city water system rehabilitation.

Cline-yes, Freeman-yes, Harrison-yes, Reeves-yes, Smalling-yes.

Motion carried.

Motion David Harrison second Dawn Freeman to decline the bid of \$53,472.00 from Kemp Bros. at this time for the water line extension down Old Hwy 52 to Macon County line.

Freeman-yes, Harrison-yes, Reeves-yes, Smalling-yes, Cline-no. Motion passed.

Motion by Larry Reeves second Dawn Freeman to pass on second and final reading Ordinance 516 – Regulation of Sale of Beer.

Since no public hearing was scheduled, Ricky Cline moved to suspend the rule and allow public comments. Second David Harrison. Roll call vote taken: Harrison-yes, Reeves-no, Smalling-yes, Cline-yes, Freeman-yes.

Motion passed.

Mayor allowed 3 to speak – Jerry Kirkman, Sharron Morris, and David Wilkerson. All were property owners and registered voters in City limits of Westmoreland.

Vote was then taken on the motion for second reading on Ordinance 516. Reeves-yes, Smalling-no, Cline-no, Freeman-yes, Harrison-no. Motion failed.

Meeting adjourned at 7:45 pm.
